


All-Star Game

Major League Baseball's All-Star Game was last month, and we've got a cryptic crossword to mark the occasion. Nine of the entries in this crossword have been named to the All-Star lineup; they are clued by wordplay only. The clues for the remaining thirty entries are incomplete; each of these clues must have a different MLB team name (nickname only; see next page) inserted into the clue before solving. The team names may be part of the definition or the wordplay, and punctuation might need to be altered when adding the team names.
