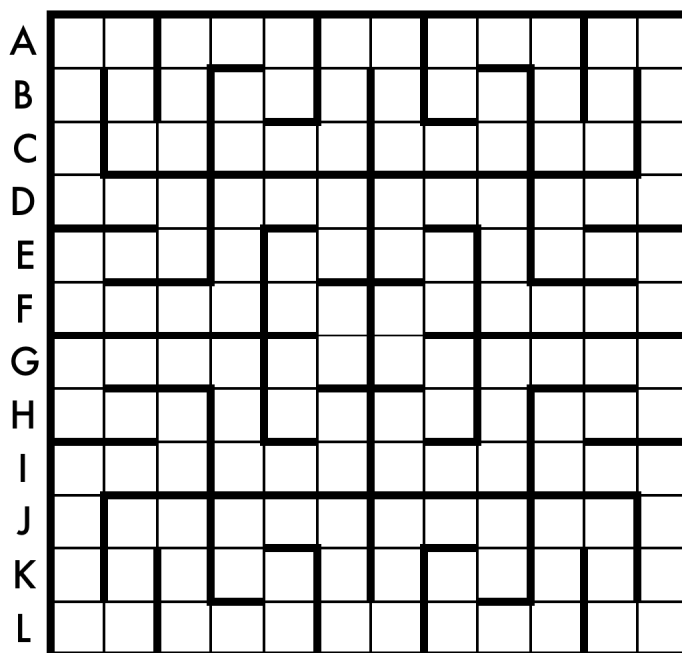


Labyrinth

Each Row of this puzzle contains two entries, placed one after the other, ignoring the walls of the labyrinth. The Winding entries are to be entered into the labyrinth, one after the other, following the twists and turns of the shaded walls. The first Winding entry begins in the upper-left square of the labyrinth, going clockwise, and the last Winding entry ends in the square just below that.
