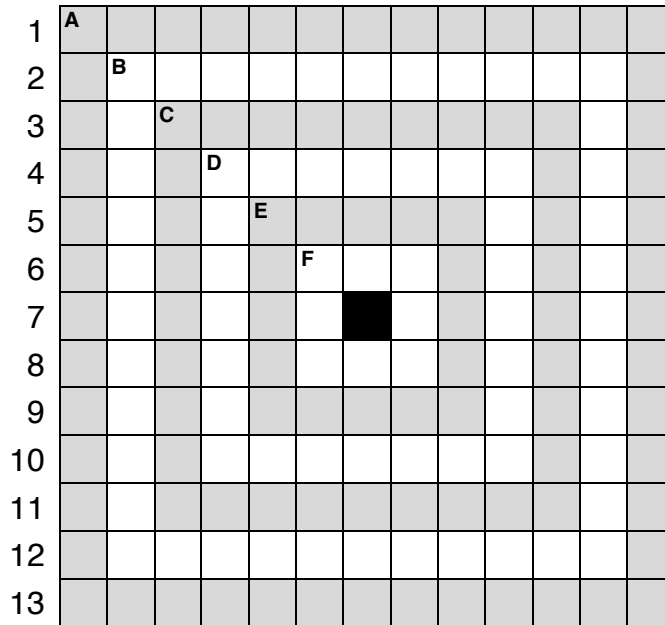


# Marching Bands #7
