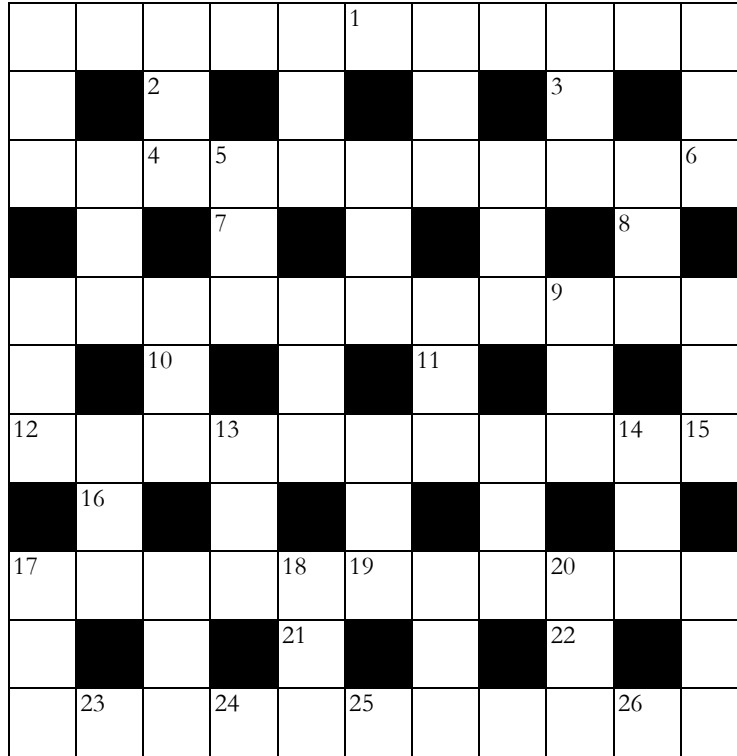


Pathfinder #7
