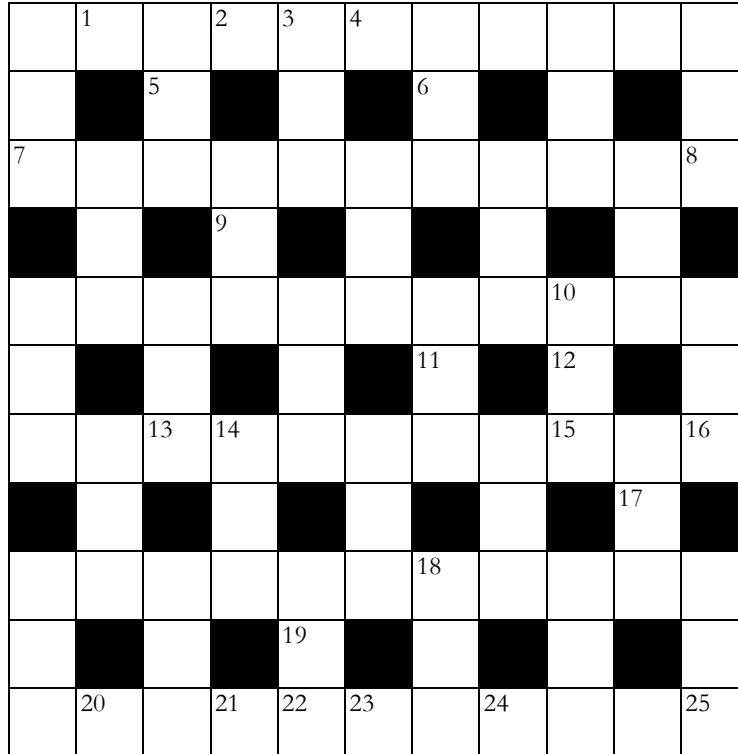


Pathfinder #10
